As well as the basic fundamentals of shooting, we will cover modern technology and how it pertains to modern shooting, and guide you through the use of devices like Kestrel meters and Rangefinders.

What do you need

Rifle, Ammunition (200rds), Shooting Mat, Ear and eye protection. 300NM or smaller calibers only. (No .338LM or .50)

Optional: Spotting scope, Backpack, Shooting bag, Bipod, Sticks, Kestrel)
