Description

We will cover rifle and equipment set-up and selection, zeroing, offsets, how to account for changes in elevation, range estimation, reading, shooting from sticks, bipods, rucksacks and improvised positions.

Distances out to 1100 yards are possible so that by the end of class a 600yd shot will be easily achievable and ethical.

We will also spend time on communications plans, safety, land navigation and working with guides.

What do you need

Rifle, Ammunition (200rds), Shooting Mat, Ear and eye protection. 300NM or smaller calibers only. (No .338LM or .50)

Optional: Spotting scope, Backpack, Shooting bag, Bipod, Sticks, Kestrel.
